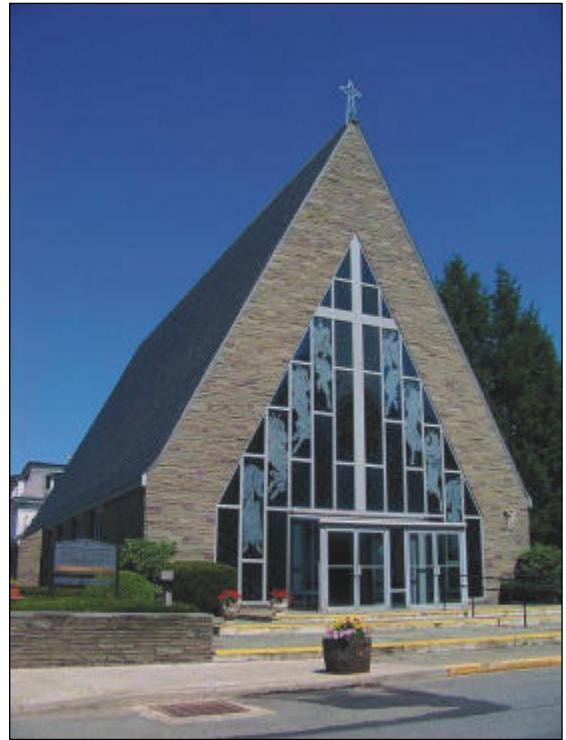

My dear friends

These are difficult times. Because of the Corona virus our government have forbidden us from attending Mass. Then they said we could attend Mass up to 30% capacity as long as we stay six feet apart. So going inside a church has seemed to become dangerous. So many have not attended during the past year. Now that we have received the covid vaccine we hope that our church buildings will reopen to capacity, so that people may come back and feel comfortable worshipping together once more. Some have watched the Mass on TV, many have not. But we all need to be at one in worshipping the God who created us and has spared those of us who remain in this life here, and Jesus who sacrificed His life by laying it down for the restoration of all.

My uncle Joe entered into the service of our country in the army and became a paratrooper at the age of eighteen, then was killed in the Battle of the Bulge on January 7th, 1945. He visited us in the summer of 1944 before he went to England preparing to enter combat in Europe. After he visited us, he visited my cousins and told them that he knew he would not be coming home from the war, that this was the last time they would see each other. He spared us from this direct encounter because I am sure he knew it would be too difficult for us.

Knowing that he was about to die in combat he proceeded to England and then to his death Allemagne France. He was literally laying down his life for us. At the bequest of His Father, Jesus did the same for us.

He told us, "This is why the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down on my own. I have power to lay it down, and power to take it up again. This command I have received from my Father." A picture is worth a thousand words. The crucifix of the crucified Christ above our altar speaks eloquently of Christ's love for us and ultimately why He has come among us.

He speaks to us again every time we come to Holy Mass. It is difficult to know Him unless we are together at Mass. Pray that, that day will come quickly so that we all may hear His voice again.
