**My Dear Friends:**

“Do not be afraid, just have faith.”

In our lifetime each of us is called upon to witness to the fact of death or the cessation of living a human life. For believers in Christ Jesus, in death life is changed not ended. Many times, Jesus would say “He or she is not dead, only sleeping.” By that He meant sleeping with a new phase of life. We die to this world to rise in the next in all reality. In today’s Gospel according to Mark, Jesus says to the father of a girl who had been told that she had died. “Do not be afraid, just have faith.” Faith is a test of our belief. Week after week in the Apostles Creed we say “I believe in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. That should give us a sense of peace and in all reality joy, that belief in Christ brings about our beliefs that death does not end at the grave but actually begins the process of resurrection, first as Christ rose from the dead after His passing on the cross.

So, death is a test. So, we believe or do we not? The Book of Wisdom 1:13-15; 2:23-24 tells us “God did not make death, nor does He rejoice in the destruction of the living. For He fashioned all things that they may have being: and the creatures of the world are wholesome and there is not a destructive drug among them nor any domain of the netherworld on earth, for justice is undying. For God formed man to be imperishable; the image of his own nature he made him. But by the envy of the devil, death entered the world, and they who belong to his company experience it.”

In Baptism we entered into the company of the living Christ. In Baptism we were buried with Him. In Baptism we rose with Him to new life. A life that, as long as we live in this grace of God, enters us into the eternal Kingdom of Heaven.

In Mark’s gospel, Chapter 5, he says, “When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So, he went in and said to them, “Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep.” And they ridicule him. Then he put them all out. He took the child by the hand and said to her, “Talitha Koum,” which means, “Little Girl, I say to you, arise!” The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat. (as He was given something to eat after His resurrection.)
