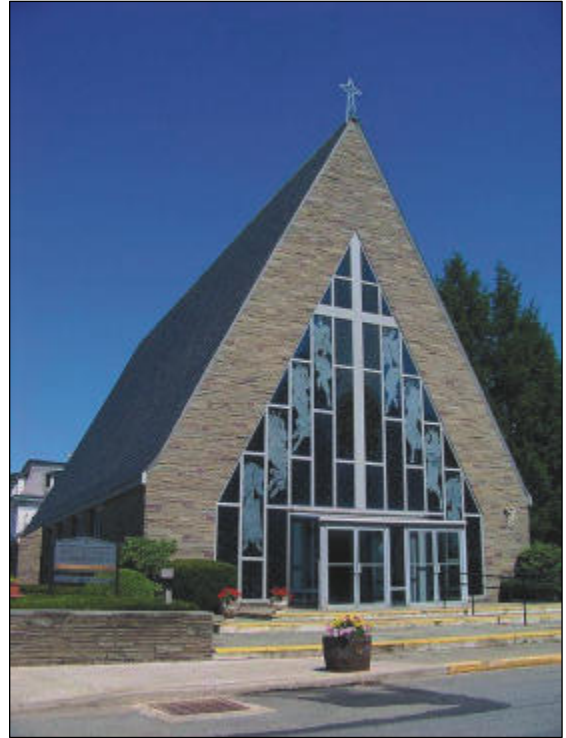

Friday June 11th is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will celebrate Mass at 6:00 pm.

My dear friends

In all reality, Jesus prepared His own last Passover with us. Then, while they were eating, He gave Himself to them in the form of bread and wine.

"He took bread, said the blessing,
Broke it, gave it to them, and said,
"Take it; this is my body."

Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them,
And they all drank from it.

He said to them,
"This is my blood of the covenant,
Which will be shed for many.

Amen I say to you,
I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine
Until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."

Then after singing a hymn,
they went out to the Mount of Olives. -St. Mark
In St. Paul's First Epistle to the Corinthians Chapter 11, verse 23 to 26, St. Paul writes;

"For I received from the Lord what I have handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night He was handed over, took bread and after He had given thanks, broke it and said "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes."

St. Thomas Aquinas speaks of Jesus. He offered his body to God the Father on the altar of the cross as a sacrifice for our reconciliation. He shed His blood for our ransom and purification, so that we might be redeemed from our wretched state of bondage and cleansed for all sin. But to ensure that the memory of so great a gift would abide with us forever, He left his body as food and his blood as drink for the faithful to consume, in the form of bread and wine.

It was to impress the vastness of this love more firmly upon the hearts of the faithful that our Lord instituted this sacrament at the Last Supper. As he was on the point of leaving the world to go to the Father, after celebrating the Passover with his disciples, he left it as a perpetual memorial of his passion. It was the fulfillment of ancient figures and the greatest of all his miracles, while for those who were to experience the sorrow of his departure, it was destined to

be a unique and abiding consolation.

And so, I give you His gift.
