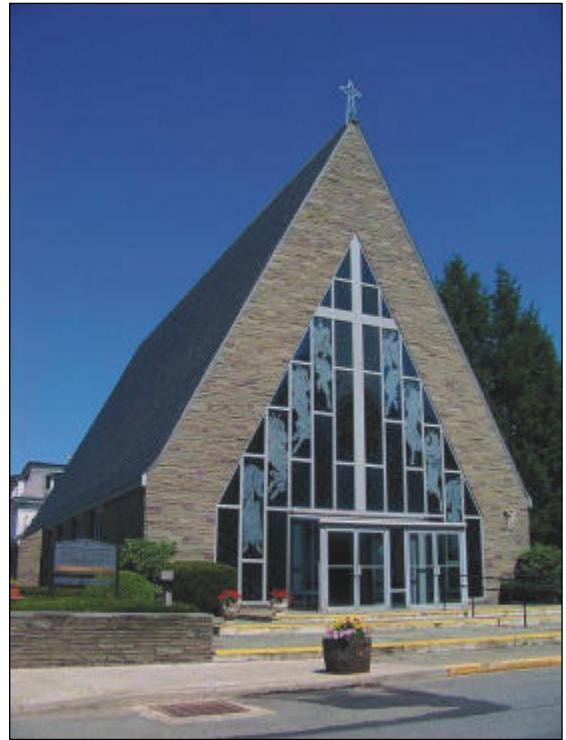

My dear friends

There is no person more sacred than a mother. A mother bears and brings forth a new life, life when brought to the Baptismal font becomes eternal life. In the meantime, there is a delicate and tender intimacy between mother and child: the image of a baby sleeping in his or her mother's arms after being nursed is brought forth in the Books of Exodus, Isaiah and the Psalms. The infant, now fed clings to his mother who takes him to her bosom. There is a closeness that is conscious and not simply biological. The Psalmist sings: "I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a child quieted at its mother's breast". Hosea puts these words on God's lips: "When Israel was a child, I loved him. . . . I took them up in my arms. . . . I led them with cords of compassion, with the bands of love, and I became to them as one who eases the yoke on their jaws, and I bent down to them and fed them".

The time of bringing forth new life in the person of a child is a time for God's blessing. After my uncle Joe was killed in the Battle of the Bulge, my grandmother had printed a small prayer book "Blessings Before and After Childbirth" which was given to every mother after birthing a child in St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester. These prayers are now contained in the Rite of Baptism, which brings forth the new and eternal spiritual life of the child. This child is now holy, a holy child of God.

So, God is intentionally united with each mother bringing forth His new life.

May each mother continue to feed her child with spiritual wisdom, the wisdom of God is love, which casts out all fear, but relies on the powerful love of God to bring its growth.

Instead of anger, my grandmother relied on God's love to bring her through this grave hour in her life.

So, we must teach our children to love. The best way we can do this is to bring about a continual giving of love so that our children may grow in love and return that love to their mothers and share it to all others. Church is their second home.
