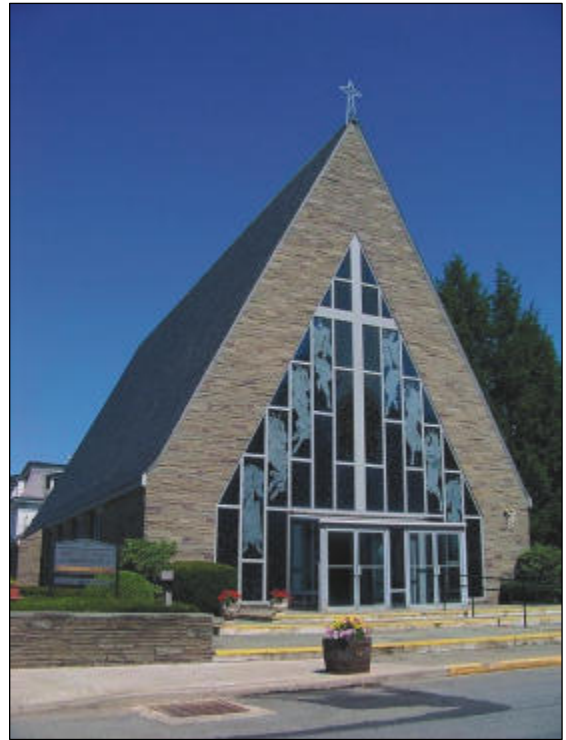

**My dear friends**

Today as on the first Easter evening Jesus creates the features that will be part of every true Christian community until the end of time. His peace, His presence, and His purpose.

He always brings with Him His message of forgiveness

---

and repentance.

Our repentance brings new life, healing, forgiveness, and peace. We become on a continuing basis His new creation in a world sorely in need of a much of a new creation.

We have our advocate in Christ.

In the upper room on Easter evening, He asks the apostles for something to eat. They gave Him a piece of baked fish. He took it and ate it in front of them.

Then He opened their minds to understand the scriptures

“Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day  
And that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name  
to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.  
You are witnesses to these things.”

Today He comes to feed us with His own body and blood, gifts that He could not give without Himself paying the ultimate sacrifice.

Jesus comes into our individual life bringing with Him those special gifts which each of us need. He brings His peaceful presences.

He comes, as He did on that first Easter night to send us on our way to be witnesses of His new way of life.

After receiving Jesus, the food of our life in Holy Communion maybe we can pause and ask ourselves, “How am I doing to find Jesus this week in the poor, the downtrodden, the anxious, the lonely? How will I respond to those red flags as they present themselves to me each day?

What am I doing to bring the Presences of Jesus alive in this community of faith, in the larger community in which I live, and ultimately in the community of our world?

Faith in Christ, when it takes shape in us, give stability to my life. When shared, it brings the living presence of God to life in our world. Only we, as human beings redeemed by Jesus can show Him in a quiet way to others. Not shouting out not breaking the reed that is weak, not blowing out the candle of hope,” but ministering to each other in love.

The story of Easter is here to stay.

It begins with peace which comes from forgiveness and our own witness to the love Jesus shares with us and sharing His love with and for each other.
