My Dear Friends:

We have been concentrating on the teaching of Christ on the Eucharist starting with the feeding of the five thousand with five loaves and two fishes. This examining the giving of manna to those in the Hebrew scriptures who were in need of food, on their journey to the promise land. This then fact that Jesus is the true bread came down from heaven. This then fact that Jesus the Bread of Life, the bread that is truly Jesus flesh and the wine is His Blood. "Whoever eats my flesh and drink my blood abides in Me and I in him and I will raise him up on the last day." The Jews argued how can this man give us his flesh to eat and his blood to drink? Many of Jesus disciples who were listening said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?"

Jesus responded, "Does this shock you."

"It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I spoke were Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe."

He said, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted by my Father.

As a result, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him.

Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you want to leave?"

Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."

The Eucharist is the foundational teaching of Christ. Either you believe in the Eucharist or you do not believe in Christ. It is as simple and straight forward as that.

Either you believe in the Eucharist or you do not believe in the priest who offers the Eucharist. For the meaning of priest is one who offers sacrifice. The sacrifice here is the sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Christ given to be the nourishment for our souls, our spiritual life.

Jesus said, "Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you have no life in you."

What a gift! There is none like it. It is the food which brings us into life eternal. It is Jesus Christ!
