My Dear Friends:

A reading from the letter of Saint Paul to the Ephesians
Brothers and sisters:

I, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace: one body and one Spirit, as you were also called to the one hope of your call; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Church is an assembly of the people of God. We are all united with “one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all,” says St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians.

What seems impossible for us is possible with God, witness the feeding of the 5000 people by Christ who saw this need and fulfilled it by His own power. He did it with humility, gentleness and patience. After the Apostles came back to Jesus telling Him of all they had done and taught, He invited them to come away to a deserted place and rest a while. It is good for each of us to do the same. In today’s Gospel, after he had performed this miracle of feeding the 5000 and the people wanted to carry Him off to make Him King, he withdrew again to the mountains alone. He needed rest and time to be with God His Father.

I need time to get away and be with God every week, to sort my life and grow in new energy.

Each of us, psychologist tell us need two hours a day to be by ourselves, to sort out our day, to bring our whole life’s work into perspective. We need to do this if, in St. Paul’s words, we can “live in a manner worthy of the call each of us has been given by Christ, to follow Him with all humility, gentleness and patience, being with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace”
