It has been 10 months since I was assigned to your parish and there has been much to do. Personally, I have been meditating and praying a lot on our Bishop's advice to me at the beginning of the year. The result of those conversations and prayers is the appointment of an Operations Manager for the four churches I happily serve. After talking to members of our parish community, and to Bishop Scharfenberger, the Diocese is pleased to appoint John Russell, a parishioner of Sacred Heart Stamford for 17 years, to manage the business operations of our Pastoral Network that include Sacred Heart/Stamford, St. Philip Neri/Grand Gorge, Sacred Heart/Margaretville and St. Anne's/Andes. In his role John will embrace a range of duties including office management, financial management, organizing events, expanding outreach, developing new parish-community programs and working with volunteers on current and new projects. John will report to me in this newly created position. I, in turn, will now be able to focus more heavily on typical priestly duties while John handles the material aspects of our churches. I hope and pray that he will receive support from all of you and that our four church communities will benefit from the structure. May our Heavenly Father bless John and every one of you in building our city of God in Christ.

HOW TO MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION

{cont.}

What if I live respectable life and haven't committed any sins?

It's not good enough to be well-respected and well-liked; we are to be holy as God is holy (Mt 5:48; 1 Pt 1:15-16), which means blazing brightly with divine charity, afire with the Holy Spirit. The Halos on images of the saints and angels aren't just a decorative touch – we are meant to be a light to the nations (Acts 13:47; 1 Pt 2:9). It is impossible for us on our own strength, but not impossible with God (Mt 19:26; Mk 10:27). We all need the grace of Confession and the Eucharist to become what we are called to be by virtue of our Baptism.

If you find yourself thinking you have no sins to confess and it's been some time since your last Confession, we recommend you carefully use the Examination of Conscience. If you still think yourself without sin, we recommend you ask those who know you and love you what sins they think you struggle with, what temptations or which of the deadly sins you wrestle with the most. Scripture tells us:

If we say, "We are without sin", we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing. If we say, "We have not sinned," we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (1Jn 1:8-10)
