EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

7. and 10. <u>You shall not steal; you shall not covet</u> your neighbor's goods.

Do I respect other's goods, or have I been envious and greedy, even taking what belongs to another? Have I neglected to return stolen goods or make equal restitution? Have I paid my debts? Have I wasted time at work, at school, or at home? Have I squandered my resources on non-essentials or on gambling? Have I failed to work for justice, or to support the poor and the Church in its mission? Have money or possessions become my god?

8. <u>You shall not bear false witness against your</u> <u>neighbor.</u>

Have I been honest, or have I lied, gossiped, given false testimony, ruined the good name of another, broken confidentiality, or denied the truth out of pride or hypocrisy? Have I shown mercy to others? Am I ashamed to confess a mortal sin?

Have I succumbed to one of the Seven Deadly Sins?

1. Lust; 2. Gluttony; 3. Greed; 4. Sloth; 5. Wrath; 6. Envy; 7. Pride

Am I obedient to the precepts of the Church?

- 1. To attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation, and rest from unnecessary work on these days.
- 2. To observe the days of abstinence and fasting.
- 3. To confess our sins to a priest, at least once a year.
- 4. To receive the Eucharist at least once a year during the Easter Season.
- 5. To contribute to the support of the Church.

Do I love my neighbor by performing at least one of the works of mercy on a regular basis?








FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION
