

#### **HOW TO MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION**

#### **HOW TO CONFESS**

#### 1. Make an Examination of Conscience.

Try to be thorough, but don't be terrified of forgetting a sin. Ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of anything you're forgetting. Remember that grave/mortal sins must be confessed. Venial sins should be confessed, especially if they have become habitual or there are a great many.

#### 2. Go to Confession.

Confessions may be held in confessionals in church, in pews or on chairs in the church, outside, or wherever some measure of privacy is possible. Often, you will have the choice to either confess to the priest face-to-face or from behind a screen. If both options are available, it is your choice which to use.

#### 3. When you are in the confessional, say:

"Forgive me, Father, for I have sinned. My last Confession was..." If you cannot remember when your last Confession was, just be honest. Give an estimate. The priest is glad you have come to Confession now – he is not going to judge you for how long (or how short) it's been since your last Confession.

## 4. Confess your sins in number and in kind, to the best of your recollection.

If you cannot remember, give an estimate, or indicate when something was committed more than once.

#### 5. Conclude with,

"For these and all other sins I have forgotten or did not discern, I am truly sorry".

## 6. The priest will give you a penance and ask you to make an Act of Contrition.

You can use the following:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all because they offend You, my God, Who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen.

#### 7. The priest will say the words of absolution.

You have been absolved so long as a validly ordained priest pray at least these words over you: "I absolve you from your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". Go in peace and sin no more.

8. Go and perform your penance.

## The Courage to Speak and to Act Against Abortion

The mother's womb should be the very safest place for a child. Tragically, it has become the most dangerous location - more dangerous than any battlefield or terrorist target. In some cities, about 40 percent of pregnancies end in abortion.

To defend these innocent children and to speak and act on their behalf takes courage. Perhaps family and friends may not like our pro-life stance. Perhaps we may lose business. We all know people who have had an abortion so perhaps we do not want to offend a relative or loved one. It is all too easy to make excuses or make calculations in our minds and hearts, which often results in paralyzed inaction and apathy.

We are always told of reasons why we cannot speak up against abortion. If the priest speaks in Church, he will be rebuked by some who will try to argue it's too political; if we speak in the political arena, we are told it's too religious. If we speak in the media, we are told it's too disturbing; in our schools and colleges, it's too disruptive. On the public streets, it's too distressing for children; in the business world it's too 'controversial, in the family it's too divisive, and in social settings, it's too impolite or politically incorrect.

So, if abortion is plainly wrong and inhumane (which it most definitely is), how do we do what is right and where do we go to say so? The unambiguous answer is that we must stop looking for a risk-free place to fight abortion, and have the courage to speak up in all these arenas!

Let's stop counting the cost to ourselves if we speak up and start counting the cost to the innocent children, if we remain silent.
