
Our Food Pantries are grateful for your generous giving of non-perishable food. There is a great need for food in our area.

#### A Starting Place for Catholic Families

As Upstate New Yorkers, many of us are addicted to the seasons. There is a rhythm and a pattern to the year that we come to depend upon... the same thing happens with the holidays of the year. As adults we fondly remember dressing up at Halloween, making hand-print turkeys in school around Thanksgiving time and sucking candy canes to a dangerous points at Christmas. Traditions and rhythms help give structure, meaning and excitement to our lives.

Over the past decades, many Catholics have lost the rhythm of the Church year (the "liturgical year,") which used to be foundational for many Catholic cultures all over the world. Some Catholic holy days remain, but they are largely stripped of their Christian meaning. We find ourselves trying to fit God in somewhere amid the fast-paced rhythm of our year, as opposed to living in a culture whose holidays (a word that comes from "holy days") and traditions are steeped in the things of God.

If, as parents, we want to help our children see the world through the lens of love, faith, sacrifice, and plenty of joyous celebration, we should learn how to live the liturgical year in our families. This doesn't mean we give up the holidays we have always enjoyed... it simply means, in part, that we will rediscover the deeper, life-changing meaning behind them. Living the liturgical year may seem like a foreign idea at first, but keep an open mind... it could be just what you are looking for as you try to raise healthy, loving kids!
