

How do we, as Catholic parents, teach our children to be pro-life?

To be pro-life means much more than to be "anti-abortion," but let's use abortion as an obvious example as we think about how to help our children explore the God-given dignity of all human life.

It is interesting how quickly children can understand that abortion is wrong! Simply share with your child in an age appropriate way what happens to an unborn baby during the process of abortion and his or her untarnished sense of justice and compassion allows that child to see abortion for what it really is... a great evil.

But soon, through day to day living in modern society, our children will learn about the many reasons people feel abortion is a *necessary* evil. How do we as parents help them navigate the complex issues surrounding abortion? How do we give them the facts they need and linspire them to help find *loving*, not *violent*, solutions for women in crisis pregnancy? How can we help our kids be proud to Catholic and pro-life when our society vilifies those who take a stand against promiscuity and abortions, making them appear either ridiculous or dangerous?

There are many age appropriate ways to help our children understand the dignity of every human person and to give them the hope and the tools they need to make the world a better, more loving place.
