



Confirmation imparts * an increase of sanctifying grace which makes the recipient a "perfect Christian"; * a special sacramental grace consisting in the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit and notably in the strength and courage to confess boldly the name of Christ; * an indelible character by reason of which the sacrament cannot be received again by the same person.
