Did you know that just over 107 years ago, during the spring and summer of the year 1916, an Angel | from Heaven visited three shepherd children near the little town of Fatima in the country of Portugal? The children were a brother and sister named Francesco and Jacinta Marto, and their cousin named Lúcia Santos. The Angel, who identified himself as the "Angel of Peace" and "Angel of Portugal", taught the children prayers, to make sacrifices, and to spend time in adoration of the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. As they would later come to understand, the Angel's visit was preparing them for the momentous events that would take place in the year 1917, when Our Lady, Mary the Mother of Our Lord Jesus Christ, would appear to the children six times from May to October to teach them about the Faith and give them her message for the whole world. We will learn more about that later, but for today I want to share with you and recommend that you too learn by heart and recite often the wonderfully powerful prayer taught to the children by the Angel.


Prayer of the Angel of Peace
