Yes, it is that exciting time of summer to registration for the Faith Formation Program starting in September. It is important to register now, so the books can be ordered and received before classes start.

This year there will be a major change, due to the shortage of Faith Formation catechists. The children will be homeschooling with their parents this year unless we get volunteers to help.


