

ALTAR ROSARY SOCIETY

The Sacred Heart Alter Rosary Society has been gathering once a month for several months and one of our discussions brought out the idea that we would like to call attention to and assist in enhancing our parish's donation to our local food pantry in Arkville. Realizing that some of you may donate privately, we still feel that if we could make a regular, more substantial donation once a month as a parish community it would help to grow our Catholic faith and build a connection to our surrounding community.

Our plan is that the last Sunday of the month will be designated as Community Food Pantry Sunday and we ask that each family bring one non-perishable item to leave in the collection bin at the entrance of the church. You may always bring an item or items on any Sunday, but by designating a particular Sunday, we hope to make it a more conscious and routine act as a unified, active and caring parish community.

There will be regular reminder announcements and updates if there are particular items of need at the Pantry. Again, if 30 to 40 parish family units bring just one item each, that would make a worthy donation to help our surrounding community.
