

Our special collection on Sunday, November 19 will support the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD).

More than 37million people in the United States live in poverty.

CCHD supports those living in poverty by funding programs that empower local communities to address the challenges they face. It identifies and addresses the unique obstacles people face as they work to lift themselves and their communities out of poverty.

In addition, 25% of the funds we collect remain in our diocese to fund local anti-poverty projects, including the work of Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Albany, in particular the work of their mobile outreach unit CC MOVE (Mobile Outreach Vehicle Extension). CC MOVE began as disaster response outreach unit. They have also partnered with the Regional Food Bank of Northeastern New York for mass food distributions as well as offering short term case management to individuals and families living in rural and remote areas of the Diocese. These community members are among the most likely to be unable to access supportive services for their needs due to their remote location. In being generous, you are supporting Catholic Charities' CC MOVE efforts to bring supportive services that offer a hand up, not a handout to those most in need.
