

Easter — The Basics

Here are some good things to know about the Easter season, which began on Easter. (Taken from www.pbgrace.com)

Did you know that the Resurrection is such an important event, the Church celebrates it for fifty days? That is longer than any other liturgical season!

Forty days after Easter, we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord . . . although in most dioceses of the United States, the Ascension is celebrated on the Seventh Sunday of Easter.

Fifty days after Easter we celebrate Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost officially ends the Easter season.

The liturgical color of Easter is white. Sometimes, gold or silver vestments are worn on especially important days within the Easter season.

Did you know that we celebrate Easter in an especially intense way during the Octave of Easter? "At Masses during the Octave of Easter, as on Sundays, the *Gloria*, is recited or sung. And at the end of each Mass of the Octave, the double *Alleluia* is sung at the dismissal."
