The Blessed Mother came to Heede Germany, shortly before World War II, She came to warn and admonish. She called repeatedly for <u>conversion and prayer</u>. She revealed the arrival of what her Son called a "minor judgment", and she said that "those who answered the call would have a chance to petition God for His Mercy." Mary said "this is a time for prayer. The times are serious." "The world is about to drink the dregs of the chalice of divine wrath for their innumerable sins which wound the Sacred Heart of Jesus. **Pray...pray a great deal, especially for the conversion of sinners**. I wish to be invoked as Queen of the Universe and as Queen of the Poor Souls." "**Be good**. **Surrender to the will of God**. Pray often, **especially the Rosary**. Now farewell, my children, until we meet in Heaven!"
