

August is dedicated to the our Blessed Mother Mary. "The Lady Who Commands Soldiers"

"There were supposed to be bloody clashes, ground and air strikes, tanks, mortars and rifles. Instead, there was joint prayer and peace. All thanks to the Mother of God, who answered the call of her Filipino children. She listened to their prayers and saved them, changing the hearts of those who were given orders to kill!

On Saturday, February 22, 1986,

The corruption in the Philippines had soared to a new high. Marcos issued an order to arrest the defense minister and several other people. General Fidel Ramos and 300 other military locked themselves in highway barracks on Epiphany of Saints Avenue. They announced that they would fight until they fell and would never surrender. The phone rang on the cardinals desk. "Your Eminence" said a shaky voice, "you have to help us. If you do not help us in a few hours we will not be among the living." The cardinal prayed in the chapel. He now knew what must be done. Through the Catholic radio, he called on all Catholics to defend "our friends". Go out into the street; stand in between forces of Enrile and Ramos and the oncoming tanks!" The people heard, and they acted. From all parts of the city, from the slums and more affluent neighborhoods, the crowds flooded in. In a few hours, 2 million people stood on Epiphany of Saints Avenue. They came with rosaries in their hands and prayer on their lips. Huge groups prayed the Rosary over and over. They sang Marian hymns and celebrated countless Masses on make shift altars. The people begged the Holy Mother for help. They remained at their posts for 4 days and nights. They held off 20 tanks, 6,000 soldiers, tear gas and mortars. They did this with their Rosaries and with the Blessed Virgin Mary. Soldiers that were questioned later as to why they did not strike said they saw a beautiful woman appear, She stood in front of the tanks. Her eyes were shining and she said, "Dear soldiers, stop! Do not proceed! Do not harm my children. Mother Mary asks us to pray the rosary daily.


