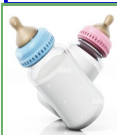

Rosary Society Announcement

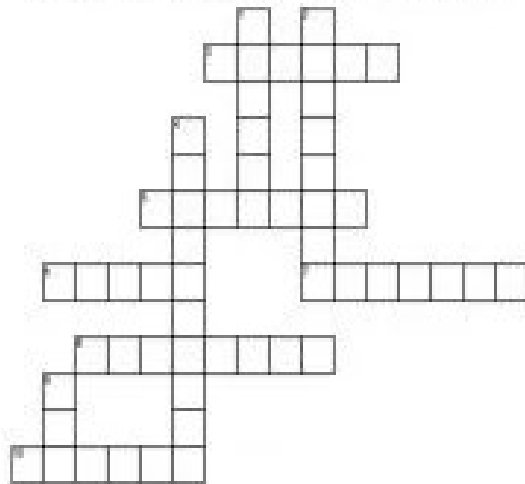
