Thoughts on Prayer from the DRCC

I like to do a jigsaw puzzle occasionally. It helps me clear my mind as I become focused on finding a color, a marking, or a shape. It takes time, and you have to be ok that you cannot complete it all at once. Sometimes you have to walk away for awhile so that you can come back with new eyes and new perspective. It is something that can be done by myself or with others.

Sometimes I think our prayer is like that:

- ~ trying to find God in the various experiences of the day
- ~ seeing how God is connecting those parts of my life
- ~ searching through apparent clutter or chaotic pieces to help make things clear
- ~ helping me to see the overall picture, which I can't know when I focus on just one bit or piece
- ~ trusting that all the pieces are there and will fit together in time
- ~ helping me to step away from my life momentarily and come back with a new perspective
- ~ allowing my faith journey to be a solo act as well as a group experience

What picture is God creating with the pieces of your life?
