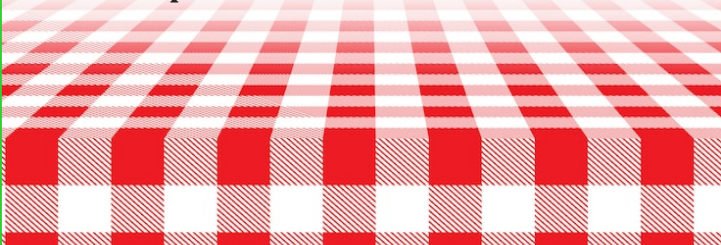

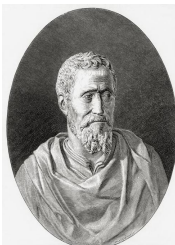

ST. AURELIUS, BISHOP OF CARTHAGE

Aurelius was Bishop of Carthage at the end of the 4th century. At the time, the churches of North Africa were split by the Donatist schism.
