

St Margaret of Scotland was also referred to as Margaret of Wessex.

She was an English princess and a Scottish queen. She was born in 1045 in Hungary and died on November 16 1093 in Edinburgh Castle, Edinburgh, Scotland.

St Margaret of Scotland loved very much to do charitable work. She would serve food to the orphans and the poor even before eating and would wash their feet, just like Jesus did.

In 1072, she also facilitated the establishment of the Benedictine monastery in Dunfermline, Fife. She also established many Churches and ferries at North Berwick and Queensferry to assist pilgrims to move across the Firth of Forth River to St Andrew's in Fife. Pious Margaret used to pray in a cave that is today known as St. Margaret's Cave.

St Margaret of Scotland was buried in the Dunfermline Abbey in Fife, Scotland. In 1560, her head was taken to Edinburgh Castle following a request by Mary Queen of Scots. Her head later ended up in France at the Jesuits' Scots College in Douai but after the French Revolution, it was lost. St Margaret of Scotland was canonized by Pope Innocent IV in 1250 in recognition of her piety, and religious reforms in Scotland.
