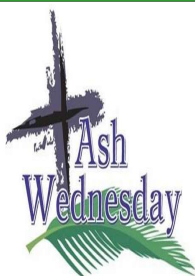

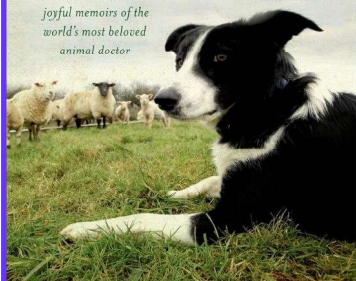

Here are the details:

The March for Life bus has 3 pickup locations:
1:00am Wade Tours, Burdeck Street, Rotterdam
1:20am Pet Smart Crossgates Commons, Washington Ave
Ext. (rear)
2:15am Catskill Park & Ride- Thruway Exit 21, Catskill,
New York

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your departure time.
There will be one stop on the way down. Approximate arrival
will be 8:00am. Departure for home will be at 5:00pm
with one stop on the way back. Arrival back to the Capital
District will be 11:30am (approximate).

The bus will be parked at Basilica of the National
Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington,
