Help Feed Our Neighbors

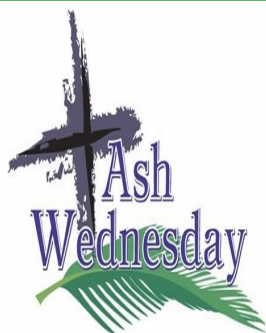
In the spirit of Christ's call to love one another, we invite you to support our local food pantry, which serves individuals and families in our community who are facing food insecurity.
