Please note: the ceremony will include the Liturgy of the Word and the Celebration of Matrimony but is not a Mass.



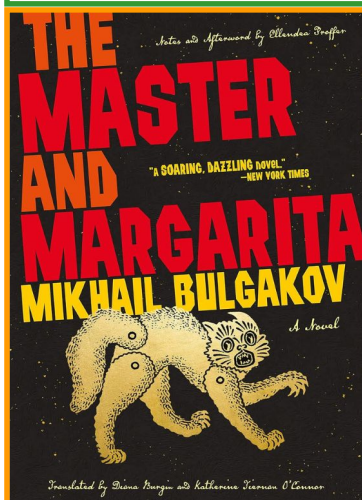
Dear Parish Family,
