Dear Fellow Parishioners,

I would like to share with you an important matter concerning the future of our church. As we continue to face increasingly high - and potentially rising - oil costs, I believe it is wise for us to begin considering whether our current heating system is the best and most sustainable option for our parish.

One possibility I would like us to explore is a **hydronic radiant floor heating system**. Such a system could potentially provide more efficient and comfortable heating while helping us plan responsibly for the long term needs of our church.

At this stage, I am not proposing that we make any decisions. Rather, I would like us to learn more, consider the costs and benefits, and prayerfully determine what might be best for our parish.

If any of you have experience with hydronic radiant floor heating system, or have knowledge about this type of project, or know somebody or a company who can help us, I would be very grateful if you would contact me at SHMargar@rcda.org. I would also like to form a small committee of **up to five parishioners** who would be willing to meet, gather information, and discuss how we might move forward with this important project.

Thank you for your concern, support, and willingness to help us care for our church and prepare wisely for its future.

Community Responsibility: All Catholics are called to be witnesses to the Gospel and to support the Faith Formation of children and youth.

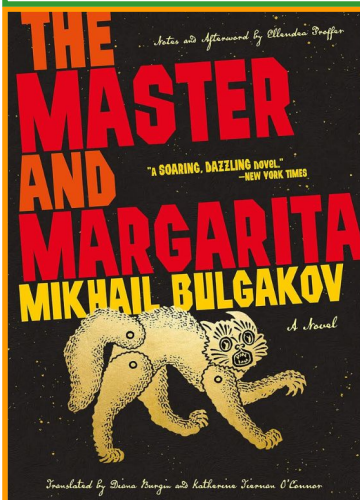
